Cost: Bring a dish to share (include ingredients and your name) and/or leave donation.

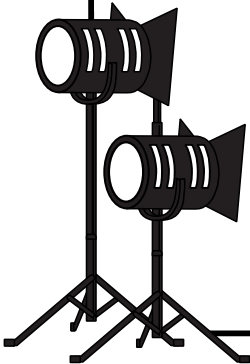
